

Kaiser Hospitalization and Emergency Room Reimbursement Policy 2026

Hospitalization Benefit

Kaiser-covered members who are admitted to a hospital for inpatient care will be eligible for reimbursement based on the length of stay, subject to the maximum eligible charges. The Plan reimburses approximately two-thirds (2/3) of the maximum eligible hospitalization charges per admission, for up to a maximum of three (3) inpatient days:

- **One (1) inpatient day:**
Maximum eligible charges of \$750, with Plan reimbursement of \$500.
- **Two (2) inpatient days:**
Maximum eligible charges of \$1,500, with Plan reimbursement of \$1,000.
- **Three (3) inpatient days:**
Maximum eligible charges of \$2,250, with Plan reimbursement of \$1,500.

Any costs incurred more than these limits are the responsibility of the member.

Emergency Room Visits

Kaiser members will be reimbursed 50% of the \$350 emergency room visit cost. The Plan reimbursement is \$175, with the remaining \$175 being the member's responsibility.

Reimbursement Process

All reimbursements are processed by the SECC HR Department. To receive reimbursement, the member must complete the Health Care Reimbursement Request Form (available under the HCAP heading) and submit the completed form with the applicable receipt by email to humanresources@seccsda.org or by fax to **951-509-2395**.
