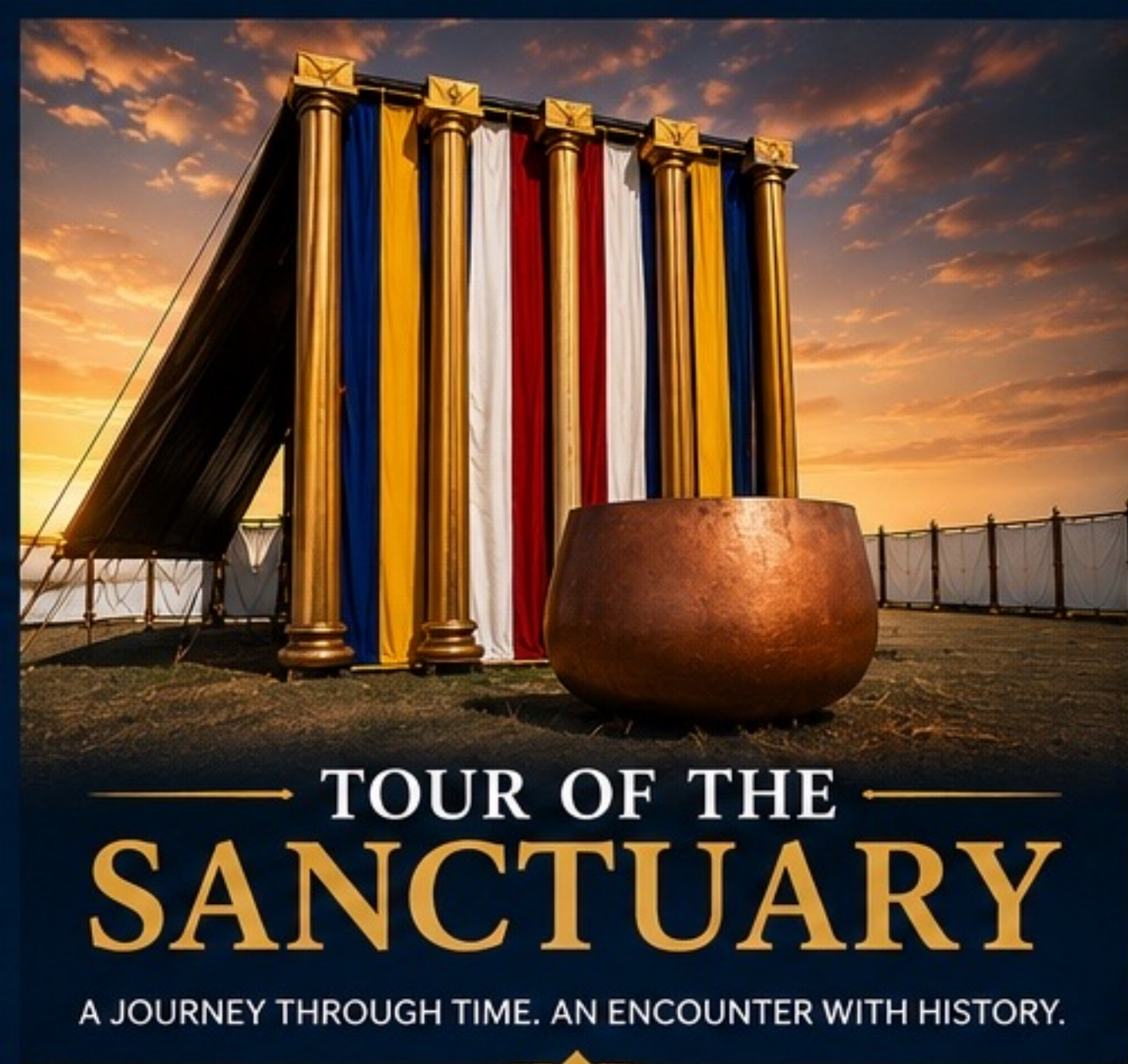




TOUR OF THE SANCTUARY

FIRST STATION

In the first station, you will gain a general overview of the structure of the Hebrew Sanctuary and its design with purpose.



THIRD STATION

In the Holy Place, learn the meaning of its three main elements: the Table of Showbread, the Altar of Incense, and the Lampstand.



FOURTH STATION

Discover the Ark of the Covenant, the only object in the Most Holy Place and the most important element of the Tabernacle.



SECOND STATION

As you enter the courtyard, your guide will explain the symbolism of humility represented by the Altar of Sacrifice and the Bronze Laver.



FIFTH STATION

The final station of the tour focuses on the special garments worn by the High Priest and how they influenced the history of the Hebrews.
